



# Hearing aids

Your employer has contracted with Kaiser Permanente to provide this added benefit.

You are covered for medically necessary hearing aids, hearing aid evaluations, and diagnostic procedures to determine the hearing aid model, which will best compensate for loss of hearing with plan providers. The following hearing aid models are covered:

- In the ear
- Behind the ear

Hearing aids—you pay nothing for one hearing aid for each ear every 36 months.





You may have seen commercials and online ads, or received mailings about Medicare plans that are available to you. While it is vital that you find a plan that fits your needs, it is important to note that your current group retiree Kaiser Permanente Medicare Advantage health plan provides very rich benefits, including low copays and supplemental options.

Kaiser Permanente offers Medicare Advantage plans for individuals, but these plans are not associated with your group coverage. If you enroll in one of these plans, in an alternate standalone Part D prescription drug plan, or another Medicare Advantage plan, your group coverage will be terminated, and you could lose out on potential employer-sponsored benefits, such as subsidies or contributions. Additionally, once you leave your group-sponsored Medicare plan you will not be able to re-enroll.
